

Th802: Exegesis of the Book of Hebrews

Study Guide

Project One

The Resource Room for course Th802 contains audio lectures for the book of Hebrews. To complete the requirements for Project One, listen to all of the lectures for the book of Hebrews.

As you listen, make notes about what you are learning. Use these notes to write a two page (minimum) summary on each chapter in the book of Hebrews. The 13 Summary Papers (a minimum of 26 pages total) are to be submitted as Project One.

Project Two

This Project provides you with the opportunity to develop skills in Greek exegesis. First, select a chapter in the book of Hebrews which you will use for this Project. Popular chapters for this Project are: one; two; four; nine; and twelve.

Section One

Write the entire chapter you selected in Microsoft Word on your computer. Do not translate any of the words. It will be best to use the King James Version because of the research sources you must use for the assignment in Section Two.

Section Two: Exegesis Paper

Use the *Greek Key-Word Study Bible*; the Greek Lexicon in the Resource Room and the written chapter on your computer from Section One. Investigate how each of the words has been used or translated in other New Testament verses. When you have completed the exegesis of a word, write the expanded translation inside a { } following the Greek word. Do this for every word in the chapter, except definite articles, prepositions, and pronouns. When you are finished, you will have written an *Amplified Chapter in the book of Hebrews*.

The length of the Exegesis Paper for the chapter you selected from the book of Hebrews must be not less than 15 pages.

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Submission Instructions,

Project One, Parts One and Two, and Project Two, must be submitted as a single unit. Use the Cover Page template in the Major Core section of the Resource Room for each Submission.
