

Th807: Eschatology: Studies in Daniel and Revelation

Study Guide

Course Overview

The information components for this course are the audio lectures on the books of Daniel and Revelation in your Resource Room.

Project One (The Theme of this Project is *Articles for Publication.*)

Note: Access the online audio lectures for the book of Daniel. Listen to the audio lectures. Make notes which are germane to the lecture information for each of the chapters in Daniel.

Part One: Using your notes, write an article on the book of Daniel for a Christian magazine. The demographics of the readers of the magazine reveal that 60% of the readers are men. The other 40% are women and teenagers. The average education of the adult readers of the magazine is bachelor level. Many of them have degrees from a Bible college or seminary. The article must be not less than 5 pages in length. Write your paper in a language and style that is appropriate for the readers.

Note: Access the online audio lectures for the book of Revelation. Listen to the lectures. Make notes which are germane to the lecture information for each of the chapters in Revelation.

Part Two: Using your notes, write an article on the book of Revelation for a Theological Journal that is published for Seminary professors. The demographics of the readers of the Journal reveal that all of the readers are men. The average education of the readers of the magazine is at master and doctoral levels. The article must be not less than 5 pages in length. Write your paper in a scholarly language and style that is appropriate for the readers.

Project Two

Part One: Write a *Prophetic Comparison* Research Paper on the books of Daniel and Revelation. Use the research sources in the Online Resource Room and outside commentaries. Select major eschatological events and individuals which / who are in both books for comparison in your Research Paper. The Paper must be not less than 10 pages in length.

Part Two: Write an *Eschatological Position* Paper. In this paper you will express your personal eschatological position Use selected portions from the lectures and books of Daniel and Revelation. You may include historical or current events to support your eschatological position. The paper must be not less than 10 pages in length.

Projects One, Parts One and Two, and Project Two, Parts One and Two, must be submitted as a single unit. Use the Cover Page template in the Major Core section of the Resource Room for each Submission. Complete the information on the form and submit it with the Two Projects for this course. The form must be the first document in the submission.
