Core One Completion Instructions

After you have thoroughly read the texts for the Old and New Testament Panoramas, the first course in Core Two: Ministry Major Curriculum. You will receive a confirmation that the Forms have been received and that the requirements for Core One: Competency in Scripture have been completed.
